



Booking Contract

This AGREEMENT (“Agreement”), made as of (date) _____,
between **Tango Tennis Argentina, LLC** (hereinafter referred to as “**TTA**”) and
_____, (hereinafter referred to as “**Customer**”).

RECITALS

TTA will use it’s best efforts to schedule the following packages offered by TTA.; **Read Clay Tennis** , Tennis & Tango, Tennis & Golf, Tennis & Polo, Tennis & Business, and Tennis & Spanish, **Sport & Language Program, Youth Tennis & Spanish Camp** – (<http://www.ttargentina.com/packages.asp>) (“**the Activities**”) for the Customer with “**the Suppliers**” in Argentina (collectively referred to as **the “Trip”**)subject to the terms of this Agreement

DOCUMENTATION

Travel Documentation: A valid passport is required to travel. It is the responsibility of the Customer to obtain all documents necessary to travel to, from, and during the Activities and the Trip.

Forms: TAA will provide all the forms that will be required for TTA to schedule the Activities and the Trip. These forms must be completely filled out and returned to TTA, together with the Trip Deposit at least 60 days prior to the first scheduled date of the Activities. Failure to complete any forms and/or pay the Trip Deposit within the 60 days timeframe will prevent the scheduling of the Activities and the Trip. There will be no exceptions to this policy

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENT

The completed forms should be sent to TTA with a non-refundable Trip Deposit in the amount of 50% of the Trip Costs per person. If TTA is able to make a booking according to your request, TTA will confirm this with you within 14 days of receipt of the forms and Trip Deposit. The balance of the Trip Costs is due in full 60 days prior to the first scheduled date of the Activities on the Trip. Trip Costs can change without prior notification and are subject to availability. However, these Trip Costs will not change once they are paid in full.

CANCELLATION

Cancellation conditions and fees: If your choice of the Activities and Trip cannot be scheduled, we will offer an alternative choice at the same price.

If, after receipt of the Trip Deposit by TTA, the Customer cancels the Activities or the Trip for any reason other than TTA's inability to schedule the Activities and/or Trip requested, the Customer shall immediately pay TTA the following cancellation fees:

If cancellation is made between **75** days and **60** days prior to the first scheduled date of the Activities you will pay 50% of the Trip Cost, per person.

If cancellation is made between **60** days and 0 days prior to first scheduled date of the Activities you will pay 100% of the Trip Cost, per person.

Cancellations must be made in writing to info@ttargentina.com . The cancellation fee will be based on the date that the written cancellation request is received by TTA.

Failure to deliver all required forms and payment of the Trip Deposit and Trip Costs to TAA, before the first scheduled date of the Activities shall result in the cancellation of the Trip, and a complete forfeiture of any paid Trip Deposit and/or Trip Costs.

Only TTA can change the cancellation fees or Trip Costs.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK

WAIVER AND RELEASE

The Customer, represents that they are able to participate in the Activities and Trip without causing harm/damage to others or themselves.

Therefore, The Customer, assumes and accepts full responsibility for any injury, harm, damage, death, and/or loss of and/or damage to personal property and expenses (including attorney fees) caused or incurred directly or indirectly by them on account of their participation in the Activities or the Trip.

The Customer, for themselves and their heirs, successors and assigns hereby releases and forever discharges, and shall hold harmless and indemnify TTA, its successors and assigns, of and from any and all manner of action, cause and causes of action, suits, damages, agreements, promises, judgments, executions, claims and demands whatsoever, in law or in equity, which they ever had, now have, may have in the future, or which their heirs, successors and assigns, hereafter can, shall or may have against TTA its successors and assigns, upon or by reason of any matter, cause or thing, on account of their participation in the Activities or the Trip.

The Customer understand that traveling and/or being in **any** country may be dangerous, and that they may be injured/die and/or lose or damage personal property as a result of participation in the Activities and the Trip. Therefore, they assume all risks related to their participation in the Activities and Trip including, but not limited to: Death, injury or illness from accidents of any nature whatsoever, including, but not limited to, bodily injury of any nature, whether severe or not, which may occur as a result of participating in an activity or contact with physical surroundings or other persons; arising from travel by car, bus, plane or any other means; death, injury or illness including food poisoning/allergy arising from the provision of food or beverage by restaurants, bars, pubs or other service providers. Theft, loss or damage of my personal property while in transit or participating in the Activities and Trip. Natural disaster or other disturbances, and alteration or cancellation of the Activities and Trip

INSTITUTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

TTA has made arrangements with different Suppliers to provide the Activities and Trip. The Customer understands and acknowledges that TTA is not the agent of these Suppliers, and has no control over these Suppliers, their personnel, equipment or operations, or over any third party which may provide any services, including but not limited to food, lodging, travel, training or other goods or services associated with the Activities and Trip.

The Customer understands that TTA is not liable, in whole or in part, for delays, loss, damage or injury to persons or property whatsoever, caused to the Customer before, during or after the Activities and/or the Trip.

The Customer further understands that TTA is not liable for things that are beyond its control, including but not limited to, Acts of God, weather conditions, wars, illness, quarantine, strikes, terrorism, acts or omissions on the part of the suppliers, or any defect in or failure of any equipment, vehicle, machinery or instrument.

The Customer acknowledges that TTA reserves the right to cancel the Activities and/or Trip, or to make any modifications to Activities and/or Trip due to events beyond the control of TAA.

If the Customer leaves the Activities or the Trip early, or at an unscheduled time of their own free will, the Customers will be due no refund of any kind from TAA.

INDEPENDENT ACTIVITY

The Customer understands that TTA is not responsible for any loss or damage the Customer may suffer when traveling independently, or when otherwise separated or absent from any TTA Activities or Trip. In addition, the Customer understands that any travel independently before, during or after the Activities or Trip is entirely at the Customer's own expense and risk.

HEALTH

It is the Customers responsibility to consult with a medical doctor with regard to their personal medical/health needs before engaging in the Activities or Trip. The Customer represents and warrants to TTA that there are no medical/health-related reasons or problems that preclude or restrict their participation in the Activities or Trip. The Customer has obtained the required

immunizations for the Activities and the Trip. The Customer has obtained the proper medical authorization from their physician. The Customer recognizes that TTA is not obligated to attend to any of their medical or health needs, and they assume all risk and responsibility related to these needs. The Customer agrees to pay all medical/health expenses related to the Activities and Trip.

TRAVEL AND MEDICAL INSURANCE

The Customer acknowledges that they have insurance coverage for any loss, damages, or injury/death incurred by them while participating in the Activities and Trip. They understand that TTA does not provide such coverage, and that no insurance coverage may exist through TTA to cover any loss, damages, or injury/death which the Customer may sustain or any claims which may arise as a result of their participation in the Activities and Trip.

RULES, REGULATIONS AND POLICIES

The Customer shall obey and comply at all times with all of the rules, regulations, codes and policies of TTA while participating in the Activities and Trip.

CONSENT/PRIVACY

The Customer hereby assigns and transfers to TTA all rights to publish, reproduce and use for advertising or any other purpose, any photograph, video image, and audio recording or other likeness of the Customer taken during the Activities or Trip for publicity, advertising, promotion or other commercial purposes.
